Viber



Available for IOS and Android devices.

You can make calls or send messages for free to any other Viber users around the world. Charges are incurred if calling / messaging people who do not have Viber installed.

Whatsapp



Available for IOS and Android devices.

You can make calls or send messages for free to any other Whatsapp users around the world. There is a nominal charge to download the app but after that messaging and calls are free to other users.
